Hello Parents and Guardians,

The Boys & Girls Club of Hawaii - Spalding Clubhouse will be offering a Spring Bash Program for teen youth ages 13-17. The program will be offered Monday March 12 to Friday March 16 from 10:00am to 4:00pm. The program includes all off-site excursions that expose teens to different service learning projects throughout their community. The program capacity is set at 30 teens.

The cost of the 1 week program is \$25 and the registration deadline is March 8th. This price includes all admission fees for each excursion, a club tee shirt, and transportation costs. The program does not include the cost of lunch. Teens should bring a packed lunch or money for lunch on all days. Teens must become a member of the Boys & Girls Club to participate if they are not already a member (additional cost is only \$1). This includes completing and signing the membership application and attaching a copy of the child's birth certificate or other proof of age. INFORMATION AND EXPECTATIONS

Times

- The regular time for the Spring Bash is 10:00am-4:00pm.
- The Spring Bash program will end daily at 4:00pm. The teen center will then be closed after the program.
- Thursday, March 15 the teen center will open for a lock-in sleepover at 8:00pm. Teens are not allowed to leave the teen center until the following day.
- The teen center will be closed from 4:00pm-8:00pm on Thursday, March 15. Participants may return to the club by 8:00pm for the lock-in.

Service Learning

- Each field trip is designed to teach teens about service learning and career exploration.
- Teens will log hours of volunteer work they completed during the program which can be used for scholarship opportunities in the future.

Lunch

- Teens are encouraged to bring a packed lunch daily. Healthy options are preferred (soda, candy, chips, and other junk food are not allowed at the Club). Teens may also bring money for food to buy when out on excursions.
- Beach days teens must bring a packed lunch because there are no stores in the area.

Field Trip Guidelines

- Please note the departure time for each field trip day and ensure that your teen arrives to the club on time. There will be no staff at the club once the group leaves.
- All teens must wear their club shirts on field trip days. The teens will return their shirts after each field trip and BCCH will wash them for the next day. At the end of the week, teens will take their shirts home to keep.
- If you need to reach your child on a field trip and they do not have a cell phone, you can call or text Bri at 808-218-2231 or Hali at 808-342-0547.
- All teens will be expected to be respectful and responsible on field trips.
 - Teens who *1- Do not follow the rules; 2-Do not listen to staff; 3-Require an unnecessary amount of attention that distracts staff from supervising the rest of the group; or 4-Put other youth in danger* will not be permitted to participate in the next field trip. No refunds will be given for teens who do not attend field trips.

Lock-in Information

- Girls and boys will sleep in different areas in the clubhouse
- Showers will be available for teens to use
- Both male and female chaperones will be present throughout the entire lock-in
- Please be sure to bring a pillow, blanket, hygiene products, extra clothes, and money for dinner
